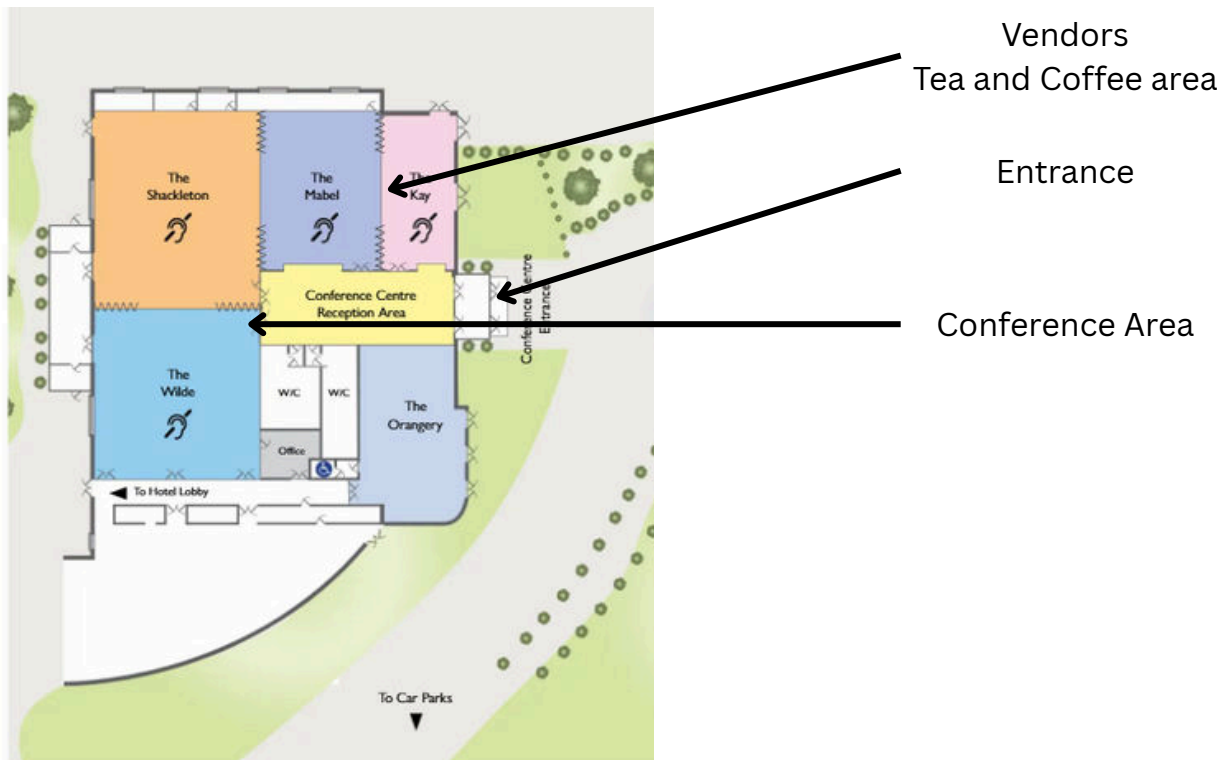


## What room will the awards be held in?

# How to get there

## **Driving from Dublin / M50**

From Dublin, take the M4 motorway towards the west.

Use **Exit 9** off the M4.

After exiting, follow local signage for Enfield / Johnstown Estate.

## **Public Transport Options**

### **Train**

The nearest train station is Enfield railway station.

The station is a 20 minute walk to the hotel.

### **Bus**

Use Local Link 189 if coming from Navan, Trim, or nearby towns.

If you're coming from Dublin, you combine Bus Éireann 115 to Enfield and then potentially a short walk or taxi from the bus stop to the hotel.

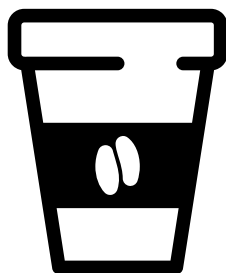

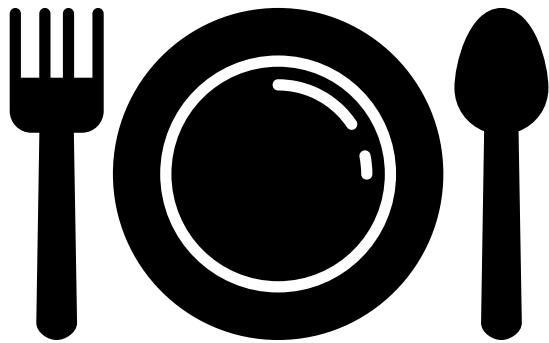
